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Introduction

The study visit to Novi Sad and transfer of knowledge and skills to stakeholders in Kazakhstan, organized by the University of Novi Sad, Serbia, was held from May 21 to May 25, 2024.

The number of participants was 20 from partner organizations in Serbia, Croatia, Greece, and Kazakhstan.

On the first day (May 21), as per the program, there was an update on the dissemination strategy. The session was attended by representatives from the University of Novi Sad, as well as colleagues from Greece who are responsible for Work Package 7, which deals with the dissemination and exploitation of project activities and results.

On the second day, through coordination between the Serbian Association of Agricultural Economists (SAAE) and the AGROKAZ team, an Agricultural Forum "Green Agenda and Agriculture" took place at the University of Novi Sad. The forum featured three panel discussions: "Green Agenda in Agriculture: Challenges and the Way Forward," "Innovations and Practices in Sustainable Agriculture," and "Education and Sustainable Agriculture."

During the first panel discussion, speeches were given by Tatjana Brankov, AGROKAZ coordinator, Tihana Sudaric from the partner institution UNIOS, Konstantinos Galanopoulos from the partner institution DUCH, and Viktor Kamkin from the partner institution PSU. Additionally, in order to encourage youth participation in the debate about the Green Agenda, students from the Faculty of Economics at the University of Novi Sad presented their research findings from a survey analyzing the perception and knowledge of youth regarding the Green Agenda and agriculture. This survey was the first of its kind in Serbia. In the second panel discussion, participants included Marija Nikolic and Olga Gavric from the Faculty of Agriculture at the University of Belgrade, Mirela Tomas Simin from the Faculty of Agriculture at the University of Novi Sad, and Gulsim Aitkhozhayeva from the partner institution KazNAU. The tird panel participants were colleagues from university as well as Djura Karaglic from the company Login EKO. The forum was relatively well-received, with two broadcasts on the state television RTV and three publications of student papers on portals in Serbia, Slovenia, and Austria so far.

The third day was dedicated to visiting the Agricultural Fair in Novi Sad, which is the largest in the region and one of the biggest agricultural fairs in Southeast Europe. It is a gathering place for farmers to exchange experiences, purchase equipment and machinery, and acquire new knowledge and practices. Many interesting topics were covered through a series of lectures, round tables, and educational events.

On the fourth day (May 24), the AGROKAZ project team visited two farms. The first was a small family farm, Soskic, which is still capable of supplying hypermarkets in Serbia with organic vegetables. The second was one of the largest and most highly IT-equipped organic farms, LoginEKO. LoginEKO addresses challenges in the food system from its 3,700-hectare organically certified farm by creating solutions to facilitate the transition to a sustainable food system, crafting a data-driven approach to sustainable agriculture, and working to simplify and automate farmers' daily tasks.





On the last day, participants finalized the results of the study visits and discussed the next steps in the project. Special focus was given on organizing upcoming meetings and addressing existing problems related to equipment procurement, laboratory accreditation, and dissemination issues.

The main goal of the project is to reduce the gap in the structure, volume and quality of labour resources from the real requirements of specific farms/enterprises and to educate professionals with competencies related to modern technologies.

The project's main objective is to develop the bachelor program in AE with DE in Kazakhstan to contribute to regional development, the improvement of the competitiveness of the agricultural sector, sustainable agroecology policy and practices, increase in innovation capacities, smart specialization trategies and support the development of lifelong learning culture using digital technologies.
